"I was in a domestic violence relationship. It was so bad I was thinking about abortion," says Jessyca.

"My mom encouraged me to check viability first. That's when I got my first ultrasound and saw two babies. I knew I would never forgive myself for aborting.

"My counselor said, 'We will help you with whatever you need.' And you absolutely did.

"The donors made it possible for me to become a good mom. Even if you have a favorite restaurant, there is going to be one time that doesn't live up to your expectations. But at Women's Care Center, **I have never once had a less than excellent experience.**"
