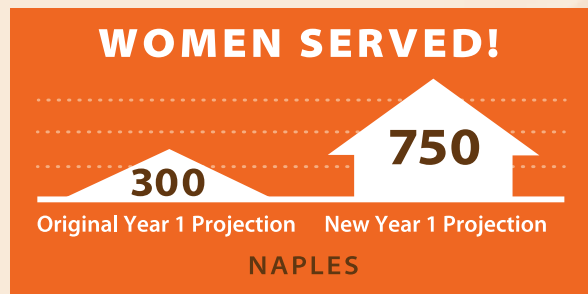

“The most valuable thing you offered me was love and understanding.

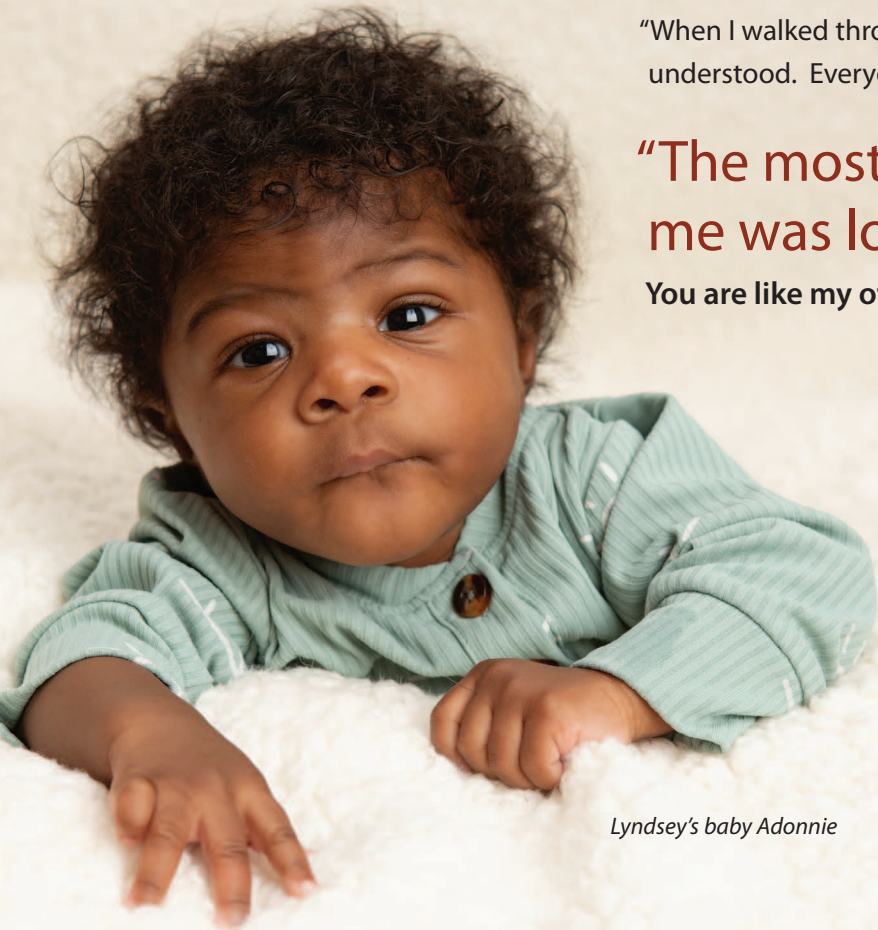
You are like my other family now.
