Destinee's counselor helped her make a pregnancy plan to take it one step at a time, enrolling her in prenatal classes and her husband in our Strong Father's program.

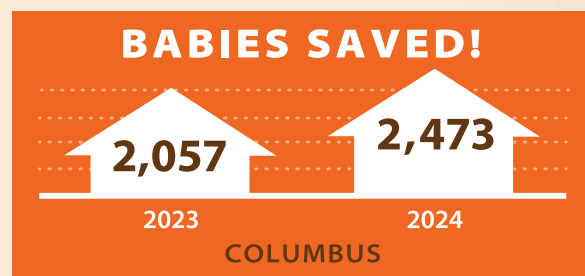
"You still reach out to me, and she is 8 months old and crawling!

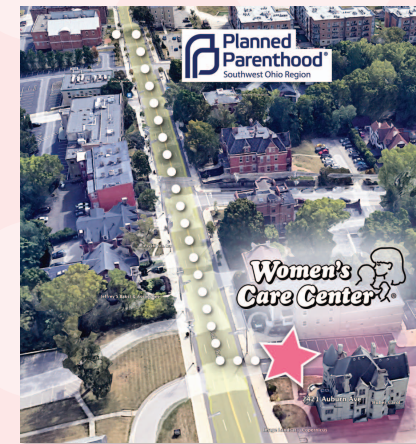

New Cincinnati Center Under Construction!

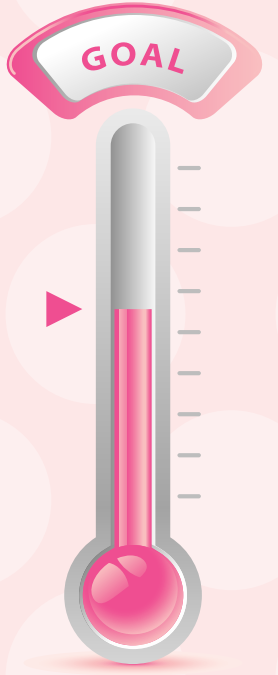

"The most valuable thing you offered me was love and understanding.

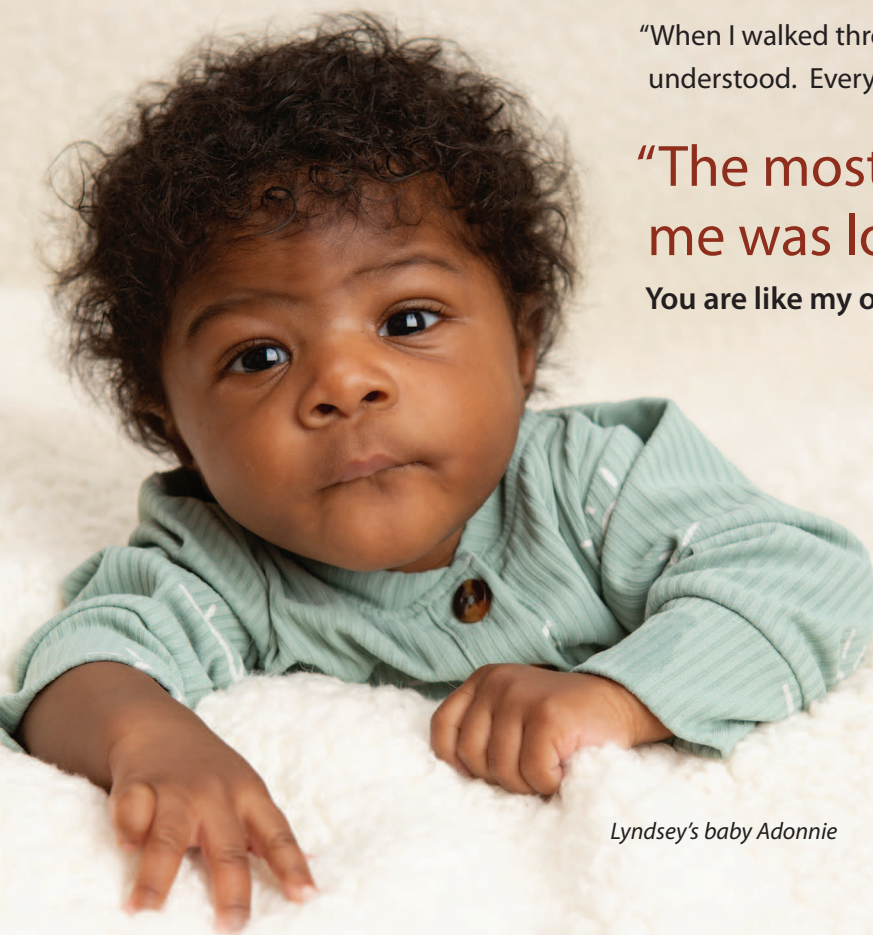
You are like my other family now.
