

*On the surface, it seems crazy!*


### WHY do so many **abortion vulnerable** women come to a pro-life center like ours?

When you think about a scared young woman sitting alone at home, having just run a pregnancy test from Walgreens and staring at a positive result...The first thing she wants is confirmation. *"Is this really happening to me?"* And, so often *"Is this real?"* quickly becomes *"I cannot do this...this is impossible."* There is an instinctive need to know for sure about something as scary and life-changing as a pregnancy.

**This is where our center comes in.** With our medical grade pregnancy tests and ultrasounds, our counselor is often the first person to "know for sure" a woman is pregnant. Before boyfriend. Before parents. Before friends. And with gentleness and compassion, our counselor not only gives a young woman the facts, but gives something far more valuable...HOPE.

And over 9 out of 10 times it leads to a decision for life.

## 3 BALTIMORE MOMS WHO FOUND HOPE:



### "I CANNOT KEEP IT."

**These were Hannah's first words to our counselor.**

Finishing up her final year of graduate school, she thought abortion was the only option. It took two ultrasounds, but Hannah fell in love with her baby and chose life. She and her boyfriend are now married and excitedly looking forward to their baby's birth.

### "THEY WERE IN SUCH A RUSH."

**said Melissa who went to the abortion clinic first.**

*"They would have done the abortion that day, but I wanted to talk."*

Instead, Melissa made her way to our center where she cried when she saw her baby on the ultrasound. Melissa chose life.

### "MY MIND IS MADE UP."

As a student/athlete, Nadia thought abortion was the only way out. But her heart was touched after counseling and an ultrasound. With her counselor, she has found resources from her family, school, and community to be able to both continue in school AND have a baby. Nadia's fiancé is thrilled to be a dad.
