




THE NEED IN BALTIMORE


Nine of ten women who receive counseling and an ultrasound ultimately choose life for their babies.

At the same time, moms and dads are being taught to be good parents through parenting classes, literacy training, self-sufficiency education, and incentive programs where parents are encouraged to set goals and finish their educations. Programs like the Crib Club baby "store" send a powerful message to women considering abortion that we will help them every step of the way as mothers.





YOU MAY NOT KNOW...

The abortion clinic across the street from our new Baltimore center is "Whole Woman's Health." This is the same abortion clinic as in Peoria, Illinois. In 2013, a Women's Care Center was opened in Peoria right next door to Whole Woman's Health in that community. Since we opened in Peoria, abortions in that community have declined 37%.

A LIFE-SAVING PARTNERSHIP

You may not know that Knights of Columbus chapters have provided dozens of ultrasound machines for our 25 Women's Care Centers in eight states. In Baltimore, the Knights of Columbus Supreme **Counsel** partnered with the **Maryland State Council** to provide this life-saving technology.
