Hayden says the ongoing help is so important. *"It's nice knowing that you are not just here until the baby is born and then, 'See ya!'"*

Lili agrees, *"I feel like I've gained friends and it's awesome."*

"Just because the sign outside says Women's Care Center, doesn't mean that you all don't help out the dads too."

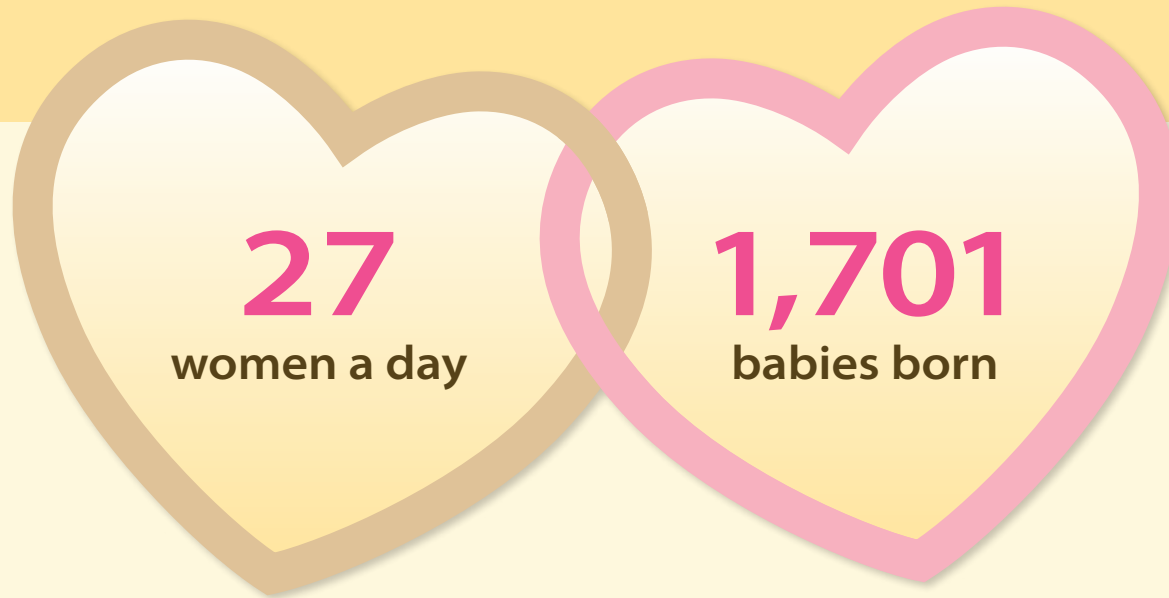

COLUMBUS HIGHLIGHTS — 2015




Women made 6,644 visits to our Columbus centers in 2015.

**Thanks to your love and support of this mission,
1 of 12 babies born in Franklin County now start with Women's Care Center.**

Our Columbus centers served 19% more women than a year ago. Nine out of 10 chose life.

Since you helped us open here in 2008, abortions have already declined 37%.

But most of all, you have helped save hundreds of moms and babies.

Jessica attended classes and worked on goals throughout her entire pregnancy.

She earned a car seat and "LOTS of diapers." Jessica says, "I started saving all of the sizes starting with newborn, and didn't buy any diapers until he was in size 3!"

Jessica still has plans to start college this fall. She wants to study something in the medical field to be able to work with babies.



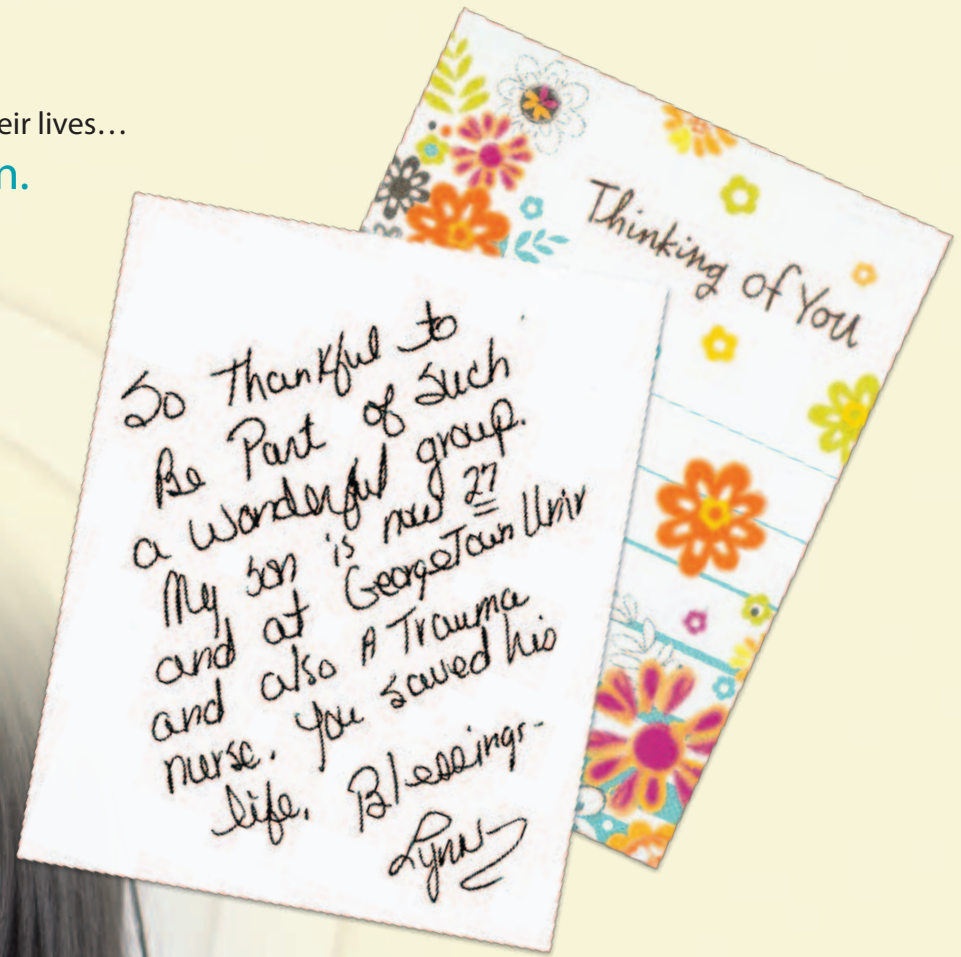


Nearly 40 moms and dads
