"Not that having a baby this young is the best way to go, but this has really put a lot of things into perspective." After dozens of visits and parenting classes, Lili and her boyfriend Hayden are excellent parents and both will start college this fall.

Hayden says the ongoing help is so important. *"It's nice knowing that you are not just here until the baby is born and then, 'See ya!'"*

Lili agrees, *"I feel like I've gained friends and it's awesome."*

Women made 1,958 visits to our Madison center in 2015.

**Thanks to your love and support of this mission,
our Madison center served 4% more women than last year.**

Nine out of 10 women chose life.

Since you helped us open here in 2012, abortions have declined 19%.

But most of all, you have helped save hundreds of moms and babies.

She earned a car seat and "LOTS of diapers." Jessica says, "I started saving all of the sizes starting with newborn, and didn't buy any diapers until he was in size 3!"

Jessica still has plans to start college this fall. She wants to study something in the medical field to be able to work with babies.
