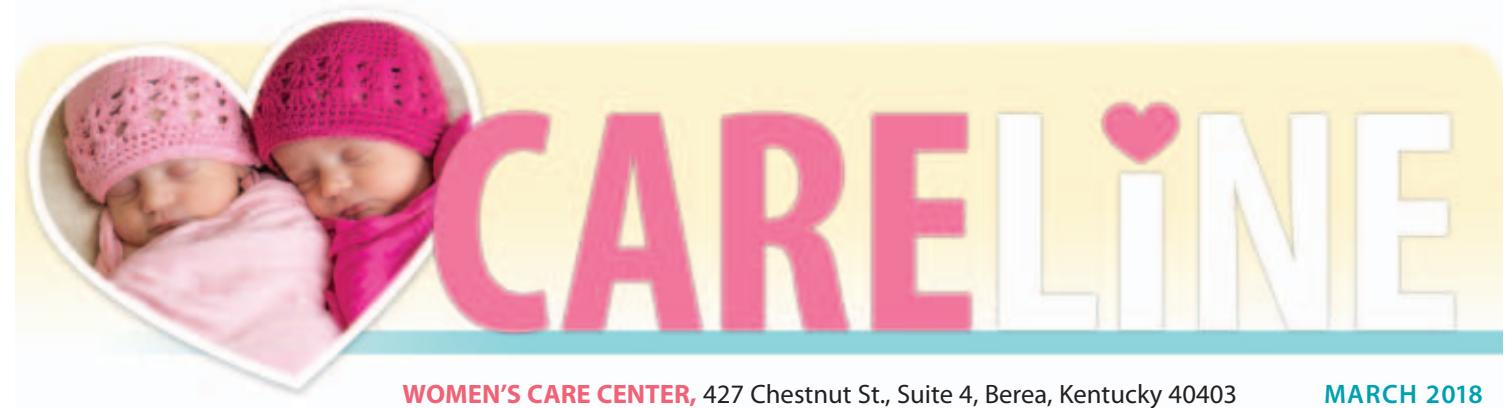

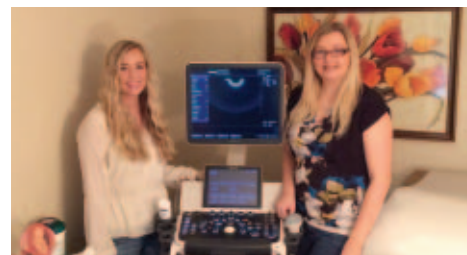
Women's Care Center **now serves 26,000 women annually** from 28 centers in 10 states.
