


SCHOOL, MARRIAGE, SECOND BABY ... in that order!

These are Jennyfer's future goals today.

A year ago, things were much different though. Jennyfer was crying at our center, worried about being pregnant, and thinking about abortion. Our counselor gently encouraged her to talk with her mom. Afraid to do that directly, Jennyfer confided in her older sister, and that did the trick! Her mom has been so supportive in encouraging her to choose life.

Jennyfer's pregnancy has only motivated her to work harder. She was accepted into a program, and is training to be a dental assistant. She completed our entire birth preparation program and attended parenting classes. She also reconnected with her faith, had her baby baptized, and has committed to abstinence.

Smiling, Jennyfer now says she wants to finish school and get married first... and then have another child.

Ambria says this now. But when she first came to us, she didn't want a baby and was thinking about abortion. Ambria had goals. She wanted to buy a house and go back to school. She thought a baby would be a huge setback.


However, the ultrasound changed everything for her. "It made him so real!" And when she found out she was having a boy, she laughingly said, "He's going to be big with a lot of muscles!"


