

You Help After a Choice For Life

You may not know the critical role you play in helping moms have healthy babies. At Women's Care Center, many of the women we see are not able to access prenatal medical care in the first trimester.

But thanks to your support, they get free prenatal vitamins and ongoing education. Right from the start! They learn about having a healthy baby, nutrition, first time moms, safe sleep and infant care.

And it works. In a two-year study at our long-time centers, women who visited 1-2 times had babies weighing an average of 6 pounds 15 ounces. Those visiting 7 or more times had babies weighing an average of 7 pounds 5 ounces.
