Located next door to one of the largest Planned Parenthood abortion clinics in Wisconsin, over **1,500 babies** have already been saved. In order to continue to serve more women and save more babies, we are adding on at Orin Road. And construction is almost complete. A separate wing for parenting classes and follow-up care will free up space in our original center for more counseling and more ultrasounds. *And that means more babies saved!*
