Women choosing life after a conversation over the phone. Car side deliveries of diapers and emergency supplies to needy families. Ultrasonographers in protective gear showing our most vulnerable clients their growing babies.

One previously abortion-bound mom said, "I'm so glad you're open. If you weren't open, people would be out here making rash decisions. Whatever you need to stay open, I will be here. If you need Clorox wipes or someone to answer the phones, I'll come."

Now, more than ever, you are transforming hearts and lives. You are essential!

"I can tell you — I don't want it to sound extreme, but it is true — you donors saved my daughter's life!" says Robin.

"Without your support, without having someone waiting there to talk to me, I wouldn't have made the decision I did. I never expected one-on-one counseling. My counselor really listened to me. And because you listened, you could tell that my mind wanted an abortion, but my heart wasn't in it."

The day of her scheduled abortion appointment, Robin just sat in the parking lot. "I couldn't go in. I wanted to be back at Women's Care Center."
