"People make you feel quilty. I was told, 'You should be finishing college first. A baby will ruin your career.'

"You showed me that I could still go to school and just because I'm having a baby doesn't mean my life is on hold. Now, I just include an extra person in it all! I am still in school and graduate in a semester.

"I called you every other day at the beginning! And it was never just, 'Here's your pregnancy test. Now, move on.'

"My mind didn't change overnight. But over the weeks, I started to realize I could do it. I kept coming back to your center. You were always here for me.

"I love my babies! Even though they are twins, they are opposites. He's outgoing, and she's sassy!"

"I was in between being homeless and living with my mom," says Mackenzie.

"It was a mess, but I got everything I needed here. My counselor would sit with me, uplift me. When I told her how I was struggling, she would say, 'You can do this!'

"I always knew she was listening to me — we had a bond. Even now, she checks in and I think, 'Wow! She still thinks about me!' And look at me now! I have my own apartment, I have insurance, I have a car!

"Even though you didn't give me any of those things physically, you got me there by pushing me to be a better mom and better person.
