Because of You...Abortions Decline!

In every community with a Women's Care Center, abortions decline. And this is because you help spread unconditional love to pregnant women in need.

It was just reported that in Columbus, abortions declined 11% during COVID-19 last year, when the rest of the state saw an increase.

And this is because you helped us stay open for in-person care when most other organizations were closed or just doing virtual care. **Thanks to you, the total abortion decline in our community is now 47% since we opened in 2008.**
