I was leaning towards abortion. I'll be all alone. I don't have anything to offer this baby."

But, thanks to you, Fany learned that wasn't true.

She had everything to offer. "My counselor heard me and listened to me. She told me to take it day by day.

She slowed me down and let me know I had time.

"In the ultrasound, I saw how small everything was, but her heart was already there.

"Having those ultrasound photos to keep looking at, kept me from making a rash decision.

"Initially, I thought about the negatives, the obstacles, but you reminded me of how much joy and laughter a baby brings."

"I was pretty mad, actually. We were young and it's such a big thing to have a baby," says Dad Peyton.

"But seeing that first ultrasound, it's kind of shocking.

You see the screen and know, 'That's the start of our baby!'

It's crazy how much you could see, even when he was

"I came to almost every class and appointment. I learned a lot here, things you don't learn at school. When I was in school, I took classes on child development. But it was nothing like here!"

Peyton says, "I was thinking about it too hard at the start. It's not what I thought it would be. Everything worked out — he's going to be a daddy's boy!"

#### You Change Hearts

"We never talked about it," says Haley. "I simply said, 'I don't think we should do this. I think we should get an abortion.' And Dylan went along with it.

"It never even crossed my mind to go anywhere but here. Maybe I secretly wanted him all along, but at first I was just so scared. At the ultrasound, we heard his heartbeat and saw it flickering. It was then I began to think, 'We can do this.'
