says Krystina.

"I was supposed to go next door to Planned Parenthood. But after I visited Women's Care Center, I never went. You were so wonderful.

"When I found out I was having twins, I was even more worried than before. I'd just gone through a tragedy [the death of her boyfriend]. I was not prepared.

"My mind didn't change overnight. But over the weeks, I started to realize I could do it. I kept coming back to Women's Care Center. You were always here for me.

"I love my babies! Even though they are twins, they are opposites. He's outgoing, and she's sassy!"

"People make you feel guilty. I was told, 'You should be finishing college first. A baby will ruin your career.'

"You showed me that I could still go to school and just because I'm having a baby doesn't mean my life is on hold. Now, I just include an extra person in it all! I am still in school and graduate in a semester.

"I called you every other day at the beginning! And it was never just, 'Here's your pregnancy test. Now, move on.'


