Mom Destiny now says,

**“Alex would not be here today without you.”**

“I was in an abusive relationship, my body was transforming faster than I could process, and I experienced prenatal depression. I became an emotional wreck halfway through my pregnancy. On week 24, I received news that my baby was not doing well. The specialist was confident my baby would not survive.

**“You encouraged me to continue my journey and to believe in the miracles that come with becoming a parent.** You saw me as a woman who needed help getting through the biggest obstacle in my life.

“My son and I are both in a great place now.”
