"I was an international student from Madagascar. I felt hopeless. I was researching abortion when I found Women's Care Center," says Fanentenana.

"After about 40 minutes of talking with my counselor, I knew I would keep my baby. And once I saw him on the ultrasound, I thought, 'He is so cute!' I was moving guickly to abortion. But here, I remembered I have always believed that babies are a blessing. I kept coming back for classes or just to have someone to talk to.

"It can be overwhelming to be a student and parent a baby. I found peace here."

AND TO THE DONORS, she says, "I just want to say thank you, because you saved me and, at the same time, you saved my baby."

So I came to Women's Care Center," says Chelsey. "The first face I saw was my counselor. She was so welcoming and compassionate. I spilled it all. She never judged me. She listened intently and reassured me that I could do this thing called 'motherhood' and that I was strong.

"And then, I had an ultrasound with one of the kindest souls I've ever met. Without that ultrasound, I don't know if my daughter would be here today.

"You knew me less than an hour and gave me the validation and strength I needed to prevent what would have been the biggest mistake of my life.

"If I could speak to the donors, I would say 'Thank you!' It's people like you, who give people hope. My daughter might not be here today, if it wasn't for you."
